Transport: You can reach Jyväskylä via Helsinki airport by flight, bus and train.

Finnair (www.finnair.com) will offer several flights between Helsinki and Jyväskylä. Monday, 29 Nov & Tuesday, 30 Nov from Helsinki (HEL) to Jyväskylä (JYV): 07:20, 12:50, 15:35, 17:55, 20:00, 20:15 and 23:40.

Tuesday, 30 Nov, Wednesday, 1 Dec & Thursday, 2 Dec from JYV to HEL: 06:10, 08:35, 13:55, 16:40, 19:00, 21:05, 21:20.

Every arrival/departure flight at Jyväskylä airport has a connecting bus to/from Jyväskylä city centre. The fare is 5 EUR and the transfer takes 30 min.

The Finnish State railways (www.vr.fi/eng) offer rail connections from Helsinki to Jyväskylä (3-3,5 hours) as well from Tampere to Jyväskylä (1,5 hours, if you fly directly to Tampere (e.g. Air Baltic, www.airbaltic.com)).
